CHARTREUSE

A hundred kilometers "as the crow flies" from Val-d'Isère, we invite you to dive into the Chartreuse massif, where we discover the first monastery of the hermit monks of the Chartreux order.

The history of the famous liqueur dates back to the early 17th century, in 1605, when the Parisian monks of the Chartreuse de Vauvert received from the hands of the Duc d'Estrées a manuscript revealing the recipe for a mysterious elixir, composed of an immense number of medicinal plants then known to apothecaries.

As the formula was highly complex, it was not studied until 1737, by the monk apothecary at Grande-Chartreuse near Grenoble.

Thirty years of study and testing were needed to establish the recipe for what became known as the "elixir végétal de la Grande-Chartreuse".

The liqueur, made from over 130 different plants, had an alcohol content of 70°. Chartreuse verte, a milder 55°, was perfected in 1840. Chartreuse jaune, even sweeter, has an alcohol content of 43°.

The history of Chartreuse production and marketing has seen some turbulent episodes: the French Revolution, the exile of the Carthusian monks to Spain in the early 20th century, and the destruction of the monks' distillery in a landslide in 1935.

The recipe is still a secret, but La Table de l'Ours invites you to discover its selection and tell its stories.
